What is In-Home Respite Care?

In-Home Respite Care is a term for personal services brought into the home for the purpose of providing caregivers with some time off, or a respite, from their caregiving responsibilities.

Who provides In-Home Respite Care?

In-Home Respite Care services are provided by Home Health Agencies, Home Care Agencies, Registries and Employment Agencies.

What services are provided?

Home Health Agencies provide skilled care services provided by medical professionals. Home Health Agencies, Home Care Agencies, Registries and Employment Agencies provide personal care and homemaker services such as housekeeping, cooking, shopping, assistance with bathing, dressing and other daily activities.
